

According to the Ordinance for Enforcement of the School Education Act, universities, as public educational institutions, are required to fulfill their accountability to society. From the perspective of improving the quality of education, the Ordinance clarifies the items of educational information that must be disclosed. Additionally, on April 1, 2025, a partial revision of the Ordinance for Enforcement of the School Education Act was made with the aim of promoting 'quality assurance open to society' by disclosing necessary information to the public and advancing dialogue with society. The revision also aims to establish the necessary regulations regarding the disclosure of information about the university's educational and research activities to assist prospective students in their decision-making, such as choosing a career path.

#### Educational information for publication

The following is a list of information that universities are required to publish, according to School Education Act Enforcement Ordinance, Article 172(2)1:

- (1) Information related to the university's educational and research objectives, policies regarding the certification of graduation or completion, policies regarding the organization and implementation of the curriculum, and policies regarding the admission of students.
  - (2) Information related to the fundamental organization of education and research.
  - (3) Information related to the faculty's research organization, the number of faculty members, and the degrees and achievements held by each faculty member.
  - (4) Information related to the selection of applicants for admission.
  - (5) Information related to the number of admitted students, enrollment capacity, number of students currently enrolled, number of graduates or those who have completed their studies, number of students continuing to higher education, number of graduates employed, and other information regarding further education and employment, as well as the number of international students.
  - (6) Information related to the courses, methods and content of instruction, as well as the annual teaching schedule.
  - (7) Information related to assessment, graduation and completion approval standards, as it relates to learning achievements;
  - (8) Information related to university land, buildings, etc., as well as facilities and other aspects of the educational and research environment provided for students;
  - (9) Information related to teaching fees, university entry costs and other fees collected by the University;
  - (10) Information related to support given by the University to students in relation to learning, future path selection and mental and physical wellbeing.
- according to School Education Act Enforcement Ordinance, Article 172(2)1:
- (11) Information related to the percentage of students who completed their studies within the standard period of study, categorized by graduate school, major, or academic track, and other information regarding the awarding of degrees.

- (12) Information related to the criteria for evaluating the thesis, as stipulated in Article 14-2, Section 2 of the Standards for the Establishment of Graduate Schools.

Information on the dissertation evaluation criteria stipulated in Article 14-2, Paragraph 2 of the Standards for the Establishment of Graduate Schools

At Kyushu University, all this information is published in the Kyushu University Handbook (published once per year) and on our website (see URL below).

In addition to the above, the University is required to collect and publish information that will help students in acquiring the skills and knowledge they require in line with the University objectives (School Education Act Enforcement Ordinance Article 172(2)4).
