Systems for co-hosting

*Outline

When an organization or an individual wishes to use the name of Kyushu University (except the name of a specific department) as a co-host, co-sponsor, and supporter for hosting a conference, study group, symposium, seminar, contest, or other event, we will determine if we will give permission or not after careful investigation based on the application.

Definition and application deadlines are as follows. Please click on the following link for more details.

【Co-hosting】

It means that the University plans and operates projects with other organizations (only when staff members of the University participate in planning or operations as a job). Apply 60 days before the day of the project.

【Cosponsor】

The University agrees with the concept of the project which is being conducted by another organizations and gives external support by approving the use of its name. Apply 20 days before the day of the project.

【Sponsorship】

Support by the University includes covering the expenses such as sponsorship money. Apply 20 days before the day of the project.

【Support】

Equivalent to the standard for sponsorship.
