

The Industrial Safety and Health Act requires businesses (Kyushu University) to implement health examinations on its workers. Members of the faculty, as workers at the University, are required to undertake these checks. The health checks implemented by the University are as shown below.

Type of health examination	Scope of implementation	Period and method of implementation
General periodic health examination	All staff (except those engaged in special designated activities and those who underwent a medical examination at the time they were employed)	June-September Rotating, undertaken at clinic on business premises
Employment health examination	Newly employed staff	As needed Undertaken at clinic on business premises
Health examination for staff being dispatched overseas	Staff working overseas for six months or longer Before and after assignment	As needed Undertaken at clinic on business premises
Health examination for staff engaged in special designated activities	Staff engaged in special designated activities	June-September, December-January Rotating, undertaken at clinic on business premises
Special health examinations	Staff working with organic solvents, designated chemical substances, dust, pressurized gases and diving	June-September, December-January Rotating, undertaken at clinic on business premises

Ionized radiation health examination	Staff handling radiation	May, September, November, February Implemented at Kyushu University Hospital
Secondary health examinations	Staff selected on basis of the results of their general health examinations (with irregularity in BMI, body fat, sugar metabolism, blood pressure)	August-November Undertaken at clinic on business premises
Tuberculosis (TB) health examination	Those who have been employed more than one year among those who were exempt for the TB test at the time they were employed  General periodic health examination and Employment health examination.	June-September Rotating, undertaken at clinic on business premises
Health examination related to products that require risk assessment	Among those who handle products that require risk assessment , a health examination may be deemed necessary.	As needed Rotating, undertaken at clinic on business premises, etc.
Stomach cancer examination	Staff aged 40 and over (optional)	June-September Undertaken at clinic on business premises
Cervical cancer examination	Optional it	June-September Undertaken at clinic on business premises
